Can you find out who Alan Turing was and why he is so significant?


We are going to be finding out why Alan Turing is so important and why he is remembered in Manchester. What did he do? Why is there a statue of him?






Can we identify different properties of materials?

In our science this half term, we will be looking and investigating materials that can be bent, squashed. Why can some materials move, but some can't?


