<p>family events</p> <p>Bring & Share Night (jacob's join)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Families pay small entrance fee and bring food/drink to share Evening can include raffles/quizzes/party games. Refreshments can also be sold at this event <p>Dad & Lads nite (Euros 2012)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dads & lads pay entrance fee Watch football match Refreshments can be sold Raffles/quizzes etc can be included <p>Cinema Show nights</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> License would allow showing, but no fee to enter Money would be made on selling refreshments popcorn etc Raffles/quizzes etc <p>Christmas Shopping Night</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Could include partylite, bodyshop, avon reps, percentage of orders to be donated back to school and/or offer raffle prizes Could include craft stall for children to make presents (cards, mugs, calendars) Sell refreshments/raffles tickets etc <p>Pamper night</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> As per Christmas shopping night but also include nail art, massage & beauty therapy treatments. Invite a professional to give talk i.e. on colouring (this is some one who advises on which colours suit which skins tones/hair colours etc – Bit of Gok! 	<p>General fund raising ideas</p> <p>Business Enterprise Scheme</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each class to create/develop a product Each class has a stall to sell products, profits to go back to school/PTFA <p>Jumble Sale/Car Boot</p> <p>School Calendar</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each person appears on the calendar for the month of their birthday. Each month could be themed Percentage of each sale comes back to school. <p>Raffles for parent assemblies</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prizes donated by local businesses i.e. hairdressers/restaurants etc or bought out of PTFA funds Tickets sold before the assembly and drawn out at the end of each assembly. <p>Pennies for Playgrounds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each term, each class collects coppers for 1 x week The winning class wins a small prize The money raised pays for any playground equipment/markings etc School council could help decide what money is spent on. <p>Funky Fridays -In the run up to an event</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each Friday for 4 weeks to be a different theme i.e. silly sock day, wear uniform backwards Each Friday ask for a donation of something to take part i.e. chocolate/bottles – these are then used at fairs Or £1 donation which can be used to buy resources for stalls at fairs <p>Embroidered Name Tags</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Parents purchase packs of name tags and a % of the order comes back to school. <p>Bag Packing – Year 5/6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask local supermarkets (Morrisons) to allow pupils to take part.

<p>Craft stalls – themed to each fair</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • These could include local businesses who agree to give a percentage of the profits or offer raffle prizes <p>Sponsored Head/Beard Shave</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Member of staff/parent to volunteer to have beard/hair shaved for sponsorship • Could be show piece of a fair <p>Sweetie Jars</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each child donates a filled jar with sweets and each jar could be sold at fair <p>Stationery Pint Pot</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As above but each child given a plastic pint pot and fills with stationery and again could be sold at fairs <p>Home bake/Jam/Chutney stall</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Donations from parents to sell <p>At the Fair Games Room</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each class makes a game to be played at the fair i.e. pin the tail on the donkey • Children/parents pay small fee to enter the room and/or pay to play each game • Prizes to be small lollies/pencils etc <p>Good as New Stall</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Could include a stall with clothes and/or games, jigsaws etc and books 	<p>Murder mystery/theme nights</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pay to enter (perhaps include food) • Refreshments can be sold • Themed raffles/quizzes can be included <p>Bingo night – these could also be family focussed</p> <p>Poker night – betting license would need investigating</p> <p>Curry taster night</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pay to enter (local restaurant could cater) • Raffles/quizzes etc <p>Salsa/Zumba/Disco nights</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pay to enter (perhaps inc food in cost) • Raffles/spot prizes <p>Fashion Shows</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pay to enter • Percentage of profits to school • Refreshments could be sold • raffles
