



Spring Term in Year 3

English

In reading we will be looking at The Boy who grew a dragon. Our writing will be focused on 'The bear, the piano and Little Bear's concert. This will help the children strengthened their writing skills by re-enforcing all they have learnt so far.

Maths

In Maths, we will look at multiplication and division, fractions, length and perimeter, mass and capacity.

History

In History, we will be looking at the Romans, the impact they had on Britain and how Manchester has changed since their invasion. We will also learn about World War 2 and the impact this had on Manchester.



Science

In science, we will be looking at what a fossil is, recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter and recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light

Art

In Art we will be looking at looking at settings and landscapes. Our art work will be inspired by artist Lowry. The children will also create art pieces surrounding their History topic 'the Romans'.
