## **What does our Universal SEN Offer look like at Whitegate End?**

### Universal Offer

- Respectful, positive relationships between all children and adults.
- A highly trained team of staff.
- Effective use of praise for the celebration of all achievement including effort.
- Highly adapted quality first teaching.
- Low stimulus, well organized classrooms, with hessian displays, catered for all learners.
- Learning Support Assistants planned for, and used, to maximise learning.
- All displays will be purposeful and are used as a tool to develop our pupils' learning.
- Regular verbal 'check ins' with the learning mentor, class teacher and from familiar adults within the classroom.
- Visual timetables used as a whole class approach.
- Reasonable adjustments made where necessary. For example; wobble cushions, pencil grips, repeated instruction, assistive technology, task boards, verbal and written prompts.
- Small group support from an adult when required.
- Pre-assessments/ sticky learning will be used at the start of each unit to plan the learning outcomes for all pupils.
- Instructions are given in small chunks and repeated when necessary.
- Adults will check the understanding of all pupils by using verbal/ visual confirmation.
- WAGOLL's will be used as a tool to aid learning and demonstrate the expected outcomes required by all pupils.
- Varied use of groupings – peer groupings, small mixed ability groupings, whole class, adaptive groupings.
- Activities chunked into manageable tasks with the use of scaffolds and prompts.
- Coffee mornings/ afternoons held with the SENCO for all parents/ guardians.

- Referrals made to outside external agencies such as; Speech and Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Visual Impairment team, Educational Psychology.
- SENCO and pastoral support for both children and parents/ guardians.
- Forest school provision where appropriate.
- Structured conversations when needed.

### Specialist Offer

This offer is specifically for pupils who have an Educational Health Care Plan.

- One to one adult support when required.
- Intense intervention both inside and outside of the classroom.
- Effective transition meetings/ plans between teachers, pupils and parents when transitioning to the next year group.
