



Spring Term in Year 3

English

Our writing this term will be based on our new History topic- The Romans. This will include letter writing and recapping our previous learning to create non-chronological reports. In reading we will be continuing with The Boy Who Grew Dragons to develop our reading skills.

HOW YOU CAN HELP - Please read at least 3 times a week with your child. This can be their school reading book, a library book or a book that you love to share at home.



Maths

In Maths, we will look at multiplication and division, fractions, length and perimeter, mass and capacity.

HOW YOU CAN HELP - Continue practising 2, 3, 4,5 and 10 timetables with your child and complete any allocated tasks on PowerMaths.

History

In History, we will be looking at the Romans, the impact they had on Britain and how Manchester has changed since their invasion. We will also learn about World War 2 and the impact this had on Manchester.



Science

In science, we will be looking at what a fossil is, recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter and recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light

Art

In Art we will be looking at looking at settings and landscapes. Our art work will be inspired by artist Lowry. The children will also create art pieces surrounding their History topic 'the Romans'.
